ISS Part Time Enrolment

Summary: ISS offers part time enrolment as a way to support families who desire that option. This enrolment may be requested for certain academic courses, and some level of participation in school activities and pastoral sessions is included with that enrolment.

Policy:

ISS will allow partial enrolment of students for any courses offered under the following conditions:

- 1. Students must apply and be screened for appropriateness much as full time students are, with emphasis on the ability to perform successfully in the programs requested; final admissions decisions will be made by the Head of School/Principal;
- 2. Students will be called Part-Time Students;
- 3. Students must enroll in whole terms;
- 4. The family will pay in advance: High School-\$2000/semester; Middle School \$1000/term for the first course, and for additional courses \$800/course/term (for courses that meet 4 times per week) and \$600/course/term (for courses that meet 3 times per week) for Middle School; and \$300/Term for Primary courses;
- 5. Part-Time Students must attend and participate in courses or activities in which they are enrolled on the same basis as all other students;
- 6. Part-Time Students must wear school uniforms:
- 7. Part-Time Students must attend one pastoral class session per week;
- 8. Part-Time Students may participate in one activity per week including sports teams and school-wide activities;
- 9. Part-Time Students must follow school behavioral standards and rules similar to other students;
- 10. Courses and activities that are full will give priority to full-time students; and
- 11. Part-Time Students may be put on probation if they are not succeeding a) academically, b) socially, c) behaviorally, or d) emotionally. Probation documentation will include criteria for success and a timeline for achieving it to remain enrolled.
